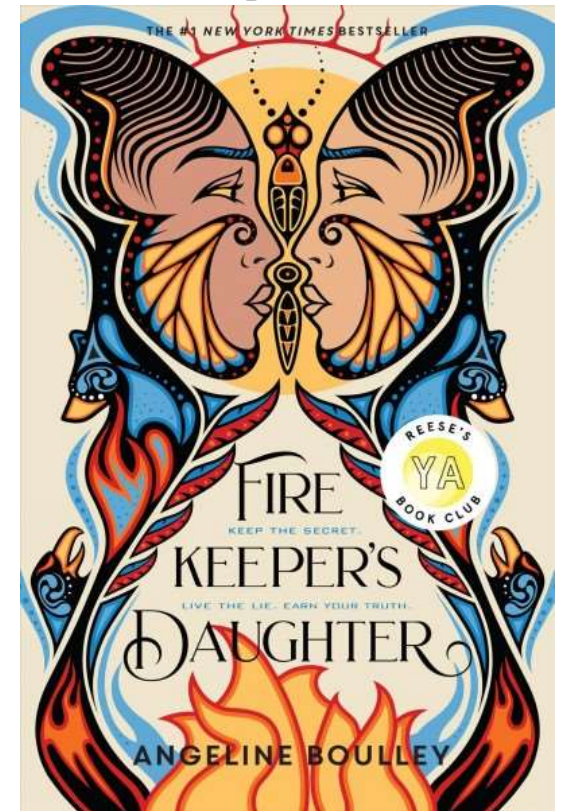
A pho love story

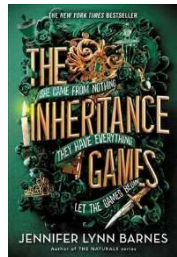


Firekeeper's daughters

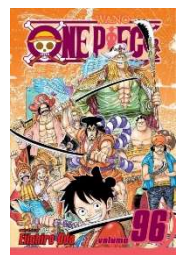

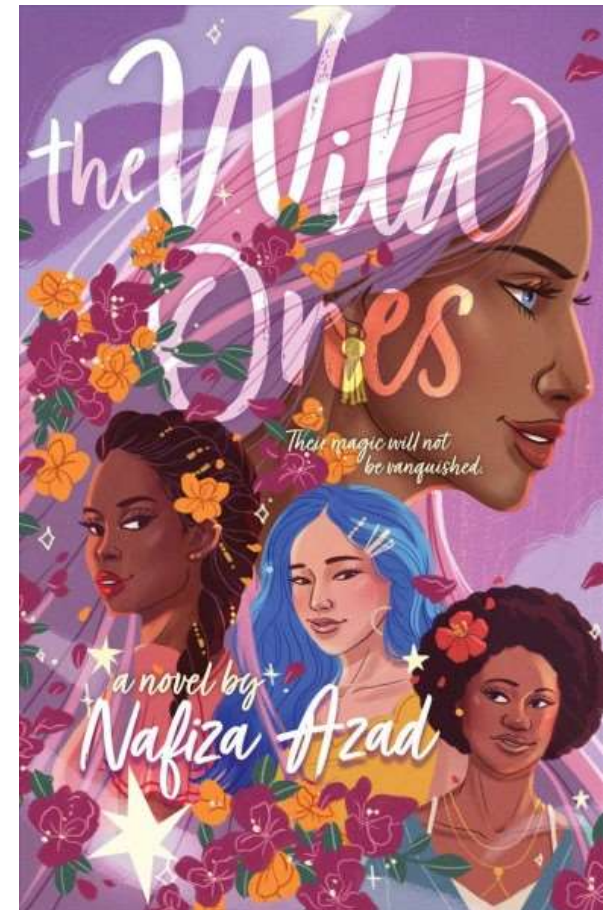


You have a match
