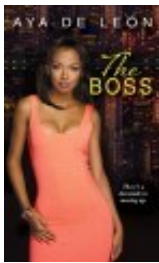
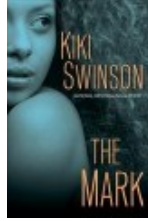


Heaven and Earth by J.M. Benjamin

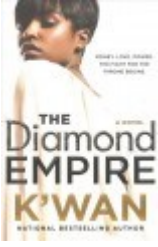


What Bae Won't Do Saga by Genesis Woods

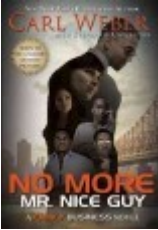
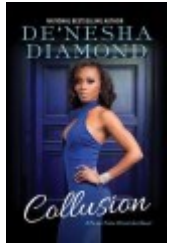


The Diamond Empire by K'wan

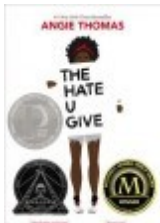
Collusion by De'nesha Diamond

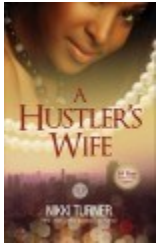


The Hate U Give by Angie Thomas

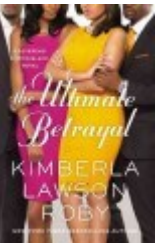
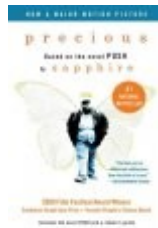


A Hustler's Wife by Nikki Turner

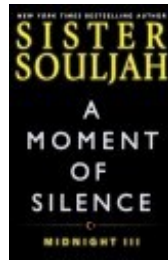
Push by Sapphire

When a woman struggles to choose between Mr. Right and the much less honorable man who holds her heart, it could lead to...the Ultimate Betrayal .



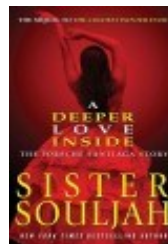
A Moment of Silence by Sister Souljah
